CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support

Course Overview

To achieve CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support, a total of 13 units of competency must be completed, comprising of 7 core units and 6 elective units. Units are dependent on the packaging rules of the qualification, and electives chosen may vary based on the learner's job role, and employer or industry requirements. The trainer will assist in selecting the most appropriate units of competency to study based on the learner's desired outcome. This is a self-paced course that will take between 6 -18 months depending on the learner and their individual circumstances. Training is available in a variety of locations and can vary depending on the delivery mode selected. Our RAPAD Skilling trainers travel to the seven RAPAD council regions of Longreach, Winton, Barcaldine, Blackall-Tambo, Boulia, Diamantina, Barcoo and beyond.
