To achieve RII30920 Certificate III in Civil Construction Road Construction and Maintenance, a total of 26 units of competency must be completed, comprising of 8 core units and 18 elective units. Units are dependent on the packaging rules of the qualification, and electives chosen may vary based on the learner's job role, and employer or industry requirements. This course will take between 12-24 months depending on the learner and their individual circumstances (up to 36 months if undertaken as a Traineeship).
