Course Structure

To achieve RII20120 Certificate II in Resources and Infrastructure Work Preparation, a total of 9 units of competency must be completed, comprising of 4 core units and 5 elective units. This is a self paced course that will take between 6 -18 months depending on the learner and their individual circumstances. Training is available in a variety of locations and can vary depending on the delivery mode selected. Our RAPAD Skilling trainers travel to the seven RAPAD council regions of Longreach, Winton, Barcaldine, Blackall-Tambo, Boulia, Diamantina, Barcoo and beyond.

Credit Transfer
