# RII30920 Certificate III in Civil Construction

## Road Construction and Maintenance

### Course Overview

To achieve RII30920 Certificate III in Civil Construction Road Construction and Maintenance, a total of 25 units of competency must be completed, comprising of 8 core units and 18 elective units. Units are dependent on the packaging rules of the qualification, and electives chosen may vary based on the learner's job role, and employer or industry requirements. The trainer will assist in selecting the most appropriate units of competency to study based on the learner's desired outcome. This course will take between 12-24 months depending on the learner and their individual circumstances (up to 36 months if undertaken as a Traineeship). Training is available in a variety of locations and can vary depending on the delivery mode selected. Our RAPAD Skilling trainers travel to the seven RAPAD council regions of Longreach, Winton, Barcaldine, Blackall-Tambo, Boulia, Diamantina, Barcoo and beyond.

### Credit Transfer

Credit Transfer is available and free of charge if the learner currently already holds a unit of competency and can provide evidence documents.

### Recognition of Prior Learning

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is conducted for experienced workers seeking to have their current skills and knowledge acknowledged. The RPL process requires the collection of evidence documents to support the determined outcome.

### Award

On successful completion of all units of competency and course requirements, the learner will be awarded the RII30920 Certificate III in Civil Construction Road Construction and Maintenance.
